

GOLDEN SCHOOL AWARD CRITERIA:

- **A staff training program** in which a minimum of 80% of the staff has participated during the 2007-2008 school year
- **A school-site volunteer liaison** designated to provide leadership through recruitment, placement, training and supervision of all volunteers.
- A total number of hours in volunteer service which equals twice the number of students (FTE count) enrolled at the school
- All winners will be recognized at the Five Star Leadership Conference TBA in Fall 2009.

SILVER SCHOOL AWARD CRITERIA:

(only for secondary schools and voc. /adult educational centers)

- **The sending school must have a school-site volunteer liaison** who provides coordination of the program, placement of students, orientation and training for the students, as well as student and program evaluation.
- **The receiving school must have a school-site volunteer liaison** who provides coordination of the program, assists in the placement of the secondary school or vocational/adult education students, provides orientation and training for the receiving staff, and assists in providing for the student and program evaluation, and student volunteer supervision.
- Student volunteers and the receiving faculty must both receive orientation and training. Student volunteers must receive continuous supervision.
- The total number of student volunteer hours must equal at least one-half the total number of students (FTE count) in the sending school (example: 2000 students = 1000 volunteer hours).
- The district will operate the program in compliance with Chapter 84-336, Section 1(1), Laws of Florida.
- All volunteers must be registered and placed in the WDPV database, in order for schools to qualify for these awards.
