<b>MARGE PEARLSON AWARD</b>	<b>Lay OR Community person</b> who gives tirelessly to community education at the school or district level; This award is named for an outstanding citizen advocate who continues to dedicate her life to promoting the virtues of community education.
<b>COMMUNITY EDUCATION AWARD</b>	<b>Assistant Principal</b> who demonstrates outstanding leadership, creative programming, and community relations and partnerships at his/her worksite.
<b>SUPERINTENDENT'S AWARD</b>	<b>Principal of a community school site OR aftercare program</b> who consistently supports community education through leadership, resource allocation and programming.
<b>JOHN I. SMITH AWARD</b>	<b>Organization OR business</b> that provides outstanding support to community education at an individual school or on the district level; This award is named for an active business leader and founding member of the Coalition.
<b>LOU TASSE YOUTH VOLUNTEER AWARD</b>	<b>Volunteer, 21 and under</b> , who provides exemplary service to a community school site or aftercare program; This award honors a community education pioneer in Dade County.
<b>LOU TASSE YOUTH ADULT AWARD</b>	<b>Volunteer, 22 and older</b> , who provides exemplary service to a community school site or aftercare program; This award honors a community education pioneer in Dade County.
<b>HALL OF FAME AWARD</b>	<b>Individual, organization OR company</b> who has demonstrated lengthy commitment to community education.
<b>SCHOOL BELL AWARD</b>	<b>Teacher, activities leader, child care manager, secretary OR clerk</b> who demonstrates, beyond the requirements of job description, outstanding ability to strengthen the community school program at his/her worksite.
